REJECTION OF THE DECLARATION OF BULLFIGHTING AS AN INTANGIBLE CULTURAL HERITAGE

The Spanish government plans to start proceedings for the approval of a Citizens' Legislative Initiative, promoted by the pro-bullfighting lobby, to declare bullfighting a protected cultural heritage in Spain (Bien de Interés Cultural – BIC).
